2. Matters Arising	
<b>NR</b> advised that having explored possibility of having dual affiliation with both Wiltshire and Dorset County Cricket Boards it was not clear if this was possible or desirable. Kilmington and Stourton CC <b>(K&amp;S)</b> are affiliated to Somerset County Cricket Board so he could not see how affiliation with another County Board, with associated membership costs, would benefit the club or proposed closer relationship with <b>K&amp;S</b>	
<b>BeS</b> explained that while the Dorset Cricket Board website may not show it, <b>K&amp;S</b> does have dual affiliation. Both <b>BeS</b> and <b>BrS</b> highlighted the excellent support Dorset Cricket Board provide for Junior and specifically All Stars cricket. They explained this was not always the case with Wiltshire Cricket.	
It was agreed that as the membership costs were not excessive the club will continue to explore dual County Cricket Board affiliation.	
3. Chairman's Report	
MC Thanked everyone for attending the AGM.	
Noted the contribution made by Sophie Weir in her work as Welfare Officer during the last and previous seasons. Sophie has given notice of standing down as Welfare Officer and <b>MC</b> expressed his and the Club's appreciation of her work for the club during her tenure	

Thanked: BY for his work on the fixtures and finance KW for ground and square preparation and ensuring the Club met Government COVID regulations NR for club secretary BrS & BeS for leading the AllStars programme and coaching in general	
Frank for umpiring All the captains Tony and John for their continued support	
<b>MC</b> gave his observations on the season which took place during a very difficult period due to COVID and was very pleased with what was achieved and the fact that we were able to play a few matches. Fund raising took a hit as due to COVID we missed a number of our normal opportunities for raising money. Hopefully this will pick up again this year as restrictions eased.	
4. Secretary 's report	
ECB launch date for the All Stars programme:	
<ul> <li>Tuesday 16 March for previous participants</li> <li>Monday 22 March for the public launch.</li> </ul>	
We have submitted all the required documents to support our programme. Waiting for approval of meeting the required First Aid (since received) and Safe Hands requirements. Issue appears to be over Wiltshire Cricket Board requirement for attending a Safe Hands course. <b>BeS</b> explained this was due to Wiltshire adopting a stance not required by the ECB. <b>BeS</b> and <b>BrS</b> taking this forward with Wiltshire.	
<b>BrS</b> also mentioned that <b>BeS</b> is to arrange a first aid course for all coaches can attending, including <b>K&amp;S</b> coaches if they have to renew their current certificates.	
According to latest government advice, grassroots cricket is due to return from 29 March, assuming the easing of lockdown regulations go to plan. <b>BeS</b> mentioned that the County views circulating at the moment suggest this might be a bit optimistic.	
Need for everyone involved in coaching to check that they have a current / valid DBS certificate.	
ECB has advised that it is changing the name of the Club Welfare Officer role to that of Club Safeguarding Officer. This is to ensure consistency across the various roles and has asked all regulated cricket clubs to make the necessary changes to their officer lists.	
Renewal of our affiliation to Wiltshire Cricket Board was due by 09 March. <b>BY</b> confirmed that the necessary payment has been made.	
We are required to provide a list of Club Officers to the Wiltshire Cricket Board through the Play Cricket site. This will be done once we have completed the Election of Officers during this AGM	NR
5. Youth Development	
Agreed that communication and marketing of opportunities to participate in youth cricket should be through social media i.e., Facebook.	
23 April is the proposed launch date for youth cricket this season. <b>GC</b> will arrange a junior committee meeting for coaches	GC
MC confirmed that we will also have a dedicated page in Mere Matters for communication each month	
6. Ground Sharing Proposals	
MC and KW provided an update on developments.	
K&S is keen to continue using the Mere ground and pitch. Both clubs see benefit in a closer relationship	

covering ground sharing and coaching juniors.	
K&S will be running 3 Saturday sides and would like to use the Mere pitch for some third team matches. Mere Town Council has not raised any objections. <b>NR</b> highlighted the need to ensure both clubs had adequate insurance for this arrangement to cover any liabilities for players and to the public.	
Mere will run under 9 and 11 teams. K&S will not be running teams at this level so will be directed to Mere.	
Mere and K&S will be running under 13 teams	
K&S will run two under 15 teams and will be able to include juniors from both clubs	
Need to ensure Mere senior team benefits from this proposal through increased pool of players looking to play in Sunday fixtures	
It was accepted by those present that there was merit in progressing this arrangement and agreed that <b>MC</b> and <b>KW</b> will take it forward with <b>K&amp;S</b> representatives	MC/KW
7. Fixtures	
BY Provided a list of confirmed fixtures for the forthcoming season, subject to any cancellations that might become necessary due to COVID rules. Details added below.
